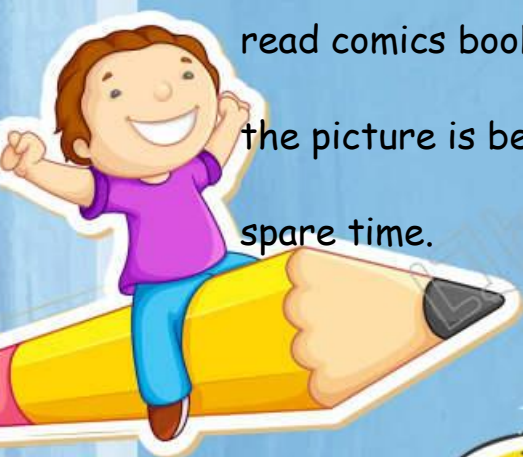


Dear Sam,

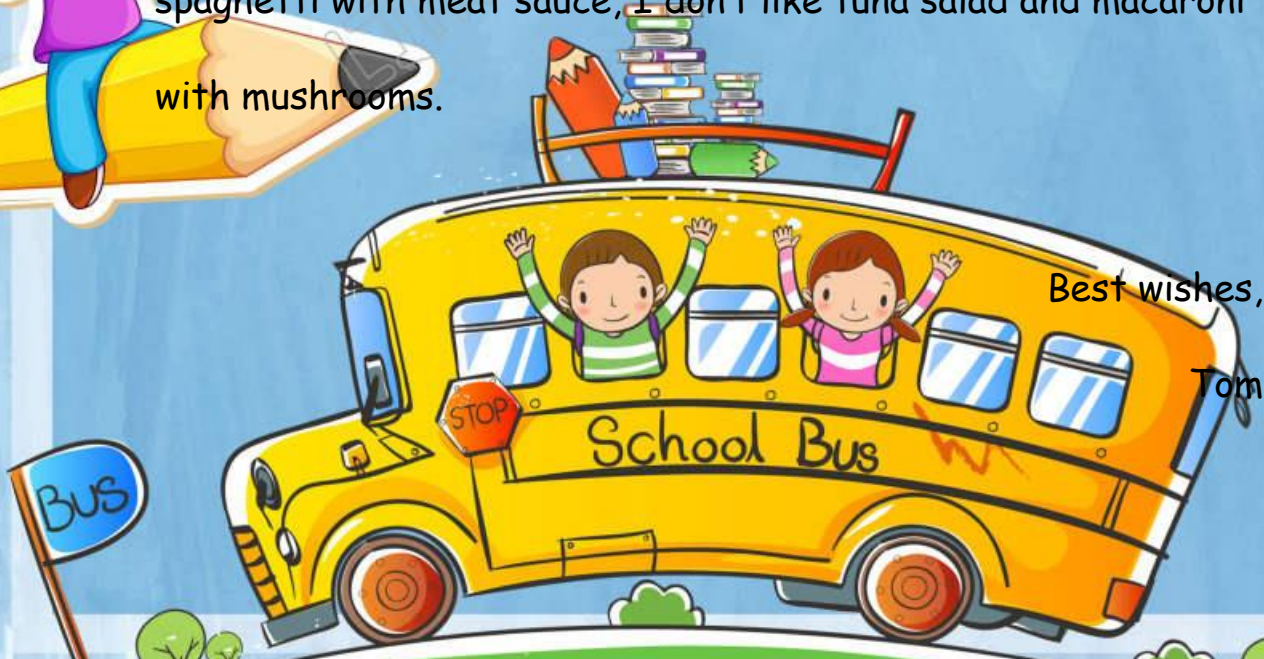
Dear Sam,
